Second Regular Session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Ninth Legislative Day, Tuesday, February 18, 2020

MESSAGES FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed and **HB 1111** and **HCR 1012**.

HB 1111 – By West (Kevin) and Roberts (Sean) of the House and Bergstrom of the Senate.

An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Sections 1272.1, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 and 1272.2, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2019, Sections 1272.1 and 1272.2), which relate to the carrying of firearms where liquor is consumed; updating statutory references; modifying exception to include certain persons; defining term; modifying scope of prohibited act; modifying scope of prohibition against carrying a weapon in a liquor establishment; reducing and deleting certain penalties; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.22, as last amended by Section 12, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2019 (21 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 1290.22), which relates to business owners rights; expanding construing provision to include liquor stores; and providing an effective date.

HCR 1012 – By Kerbs, Kiger, Tadlock, Sterling, Grego, Humphrey, Taylor, McCall, Smith and Frix of the House and Boggs of the Senate.

A Concurrent Resolution encouraging and supporting the expansion of rail line from Shawnee to McAlester; recognizing expansion's potential for continued economic prosperity for Oklahoma.

The above-numbered measures were read the first time.

Advising concurrence in **SAs** to and passage of Engrossed **HB 1230**.
