Second Regular Session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Twenty-fifth Legislative Day, Tuesday, March 17, 2020

The Senate was called to order by Senator Stanislawski.

Senator Stanislawski declared a quorum present.

The prayer was offered by Senator Marty Quinn.

INTRODUCTION

Senator Howard introduced his wife, Jennifer, to the Senate.

SENATE RULE SUSPENDED

Senator Howard asked unanimous consent, which was granted, to suspend Senate Rules to allow immediate consideration of **HB 3888**, the floor substitute and all other amendments pertaining to **HB 3888**.

GENERAL ORDER

HB 3888 by Caldwell (Chad) of the House and Howard of the Senate was called up for consideration.

Senator Howard moved to amend **HB 3888**, by substituting the attached floor substitute for the title, enacting clause and entire body of the measure, which amendment was declared adopted. (Copies were provided for all Senators.)

Senator Howard moved to amend the floor substitute to **HB 3888**, Page 1, by restoring the title and emergency clause, which amendment was declared adopted.

Senator Howard moved that **HB 3888** be advanced, which motion was declared adopted.

THIRD READING

HB 3888 was read for the third time at length.
