# **AFA's Aerospace, Education Programs**

#### CyberPatriot

- Introduced in 2009 by the non-profit 501(c)(3) Air Force Association (AFA) to address a critical national need
- Educates young women & young men middle school through high school about careers in cybersecurity and other science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) fields to meet the needs of an increasingly technical workforce.
  - since its initial launch participation has grown from eight teams to nearly 6,800 teams in 2019. Geographically, the competition has grown from a single state (Florida) to all 50 U.S. states to include Canada, and beyond (international teams are now competing)
- StellarXplorer
  - Introduced in September 2014 by the Air Force Association (AFA) after an inquiry from the Air Force asking if AFA would consider a space version of our highly successful CyberPatriot program
    - National High School Space Challenge that involves a hands-on, space design challenge for ages 13-17 HS students
    - Involves all aspects of system concept development
    - Virtual participation using local computers

## **Career Tech and AFA**



- Partnership created in 2016
  - Milestones:
    - CyberPatriot and StellarXplorer curriculum added to the CareerTech website for all educators/teachers to use
    - Curriculum was approved to be used as Oklahoma Promise credits
    - 107 Teams across Oklahoma participated in CyberPatriot 2019
      - Central Technology Center 1 of 12 National finalists in the Open Division
    - 11 Teams across Oklahoma participated in StellarXplorer 2019 – With 3 teams from Oklahoma competing in the semifinals
    - Outreach due to this partnership continues to grow across the state with AFA attendance at CareerTech sponsored teacher/educator workshops, conferences and other training opportunities
