➤ National Violent Death Reporting System → Oklahoma Violent Death Reporting System

- CDC Cooperative Agreement since 2003 Oklahoma began in 2004.
- 50 States, Washington, D.C., and Puerto Rico
 - 32 states/territories added since 2014

 - Medical Examiner Reports
 - Death Certificates
 - Law Enforcement Reports
 - Optional
 - Supplementary homicide reports, newspapers, hospital, crime lab reports, EMS reports



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
- Most common type of violent death
- Oklahoma Child Residents Aged 0 17 Years, 2016-2020
 - 162 suicide deaths
 - Annual rate = 3.4 per 100,000 Oklahomans
 - Average of 32 deaths per year
 - 73% male, 27% female





➤ Nonfatal Intentional Self-Harm Inpatient Hospitalizations, Oklahoma, 2016-2020*






Nonfatal Intentional Self-Harm Inpatient Hospitalizations of Children under 18 Years of Age by Sex, Oklahoma, 2016-2020*








➤ Sex, Race and Ethnicity Specific Suicide Rates, Oklahoma Youth Aged 0 – 17 Years, 2015-2019

➤ Leading Suicide Methods/Means Among Children Aged 0 – 17 Years, 2016-2020

- Firearms (54% of suicides)
 - 77% handguns
 - 15% rifles
 - 8% shotguns
- Hanging/Strangulation/Suffocation (35%)
- Poisoning (6%)

- Other Suicide Methods/Means
 - Sharp/blunt instruments
 - Motor vehicle/transportation
 - Drowning
 - Fall/jump



Circumstances

- Mental Health, Substance Abuse, and other Addictions
 - Current depressed mood
 - Current diagnosed mental health problem
 - Mental illness diagnosis
 - Current mental health treatment
 - Ever treated for mental health or substance abuse
 - Alcohol problem
 - Other substance abuse problem
 - Other addiction

Relationship & Life Stressor

- Intimate partner problem
- Family relationship problem
- Other relationship problem
- Abuse or neglect led to death
- History of abuse or neglect as a child
- Previous perpetrator of violence in the past month
- Previous victim of violence in the past month
- Physical fight (2people)
- Argument
 - Timing of argument



Circumstances

- Crime & Criminal Activity
 - Precipitated by another crime
 - First crime in progress
 - Terrorist attack
- Suicide Specific Circumstances
 - History of suicide attempts
 - Recently disclosed suicidal thoughts/plan to suicide
 - To whom
 - Left a suicide note
 - History of expressed suicidal thoughts or plans
- Crisis in past 2 weeks or upcoming 2

Life Stressors

- Contributing criminal legal problem
- Civil legal problems
- Physical health problem
- Job problem
- Financial problem
- School problem
- Eviction/loss of home
- Suicide of friend or family
- Non-suicide death of friend or family
- Anniversary of traumatic event
- Disaster exposure

▶ Leading Circumstances Associated with Suicide Among Children Aged 0 – 17 Years, Oklahoma, 2015-2019

- 40% one or more diagnosed or treated mental health problems
 - Depression/dysthymia (75%),
 - Bipolar disorder (<9%),</p>
 - Anxiety disorder (25%),
 - PTSD (<9%),
 - Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (20%)
 - Other (18%)
- 34% current depressed mood
- 28% school problem
- 25% intimate partner problem

- 17% recent argument
- 8% substance abuse problem
- 7% recent crisis
- 6% death of friend/family
- 6% abused as a child
- 5% recent suicide of friend/family
- 4% Recent criminal legal problem
- <3 % physical health problem</p>
- <3% job problem</p>
- <3% traumatic anniversary</p>
- <3 % alcohol problem</p>



➤ Suicide Circumstances among Children Aged 0 – 17 Years, Oklahoma, 2015-2019

- 33% left suicide note
- 25% previously stated intent to die by suicide or suicidal feelings to another person
- 11% had suicide attempt history
- 27% had a history of suicidal thoughts

Substance Use

- 8% of persons tested were positive for alcohol
- 20% of persons tested were positive for substances other than alcohol
