OKLAHOMA OPIOID CRISIS HISTORY, DATA, STATUS, FUTURE

HISTORY

2016 Recognition that:

- You can't treat your way out of the opioid crisis
- Must stop the increasing flow of opioids
- Medical community has:
 - No control on illegal opioid flow into Okla.
 - Control and influence on Rx opioids.
- 3 prongs: Education; Legislation; Regulation

2017 Status

- only limit on opioid Rx is federal (30 day supply)
- Opioid Lawsuit filed 6/30/2017 [awareness]

2018 Legislation

- Medical facilities to register and use PMP (Prescription Monitoring Program)
- Foreign distributors to register and use PMP
- Creation of overdose review board
- E-Rx requirement
- Tribes' authority to use PMP
- Good Samaritan Law
- Pill limits
- AG Task Force created (non-legislative body)
- Opioid Coalition Formed (associations, agencies, interested parties)

2019 Legislation

- Medical education requirements
- Legislative formalization of opioid task force
- Clean up bills re PMP, E-Rx, Pill Limits
- Best Practices published (medical community)

2020 Legislation [Covid]

- Parity for MH and SA treatment
- Appropriations re opioid crisis
- Clean up bills re PMP, E-Rx, Pill Limits

2021 Legislation

- Parity extension, telemedicine
- Clean up bills re PMP, E-Rx, Pill Limits

DATA**, Oklahoma

Pills:

2015 - 2020 Decrease 39% (329M to 129M)

Rx's:

2015 - 2020 Decrease 37% (4.5M to 1.8M)

MME:

2016 ~80,000 MME/day prescribed in Oklahoma

2021 ~46,000 MME/day prescribed in Oklahoma; 39% decrease

Overdose deaths:

2017-2019 decrease ~25%; significantly better than US Avg.

increase ~11% [Covid]; significantly better than US Avg.
