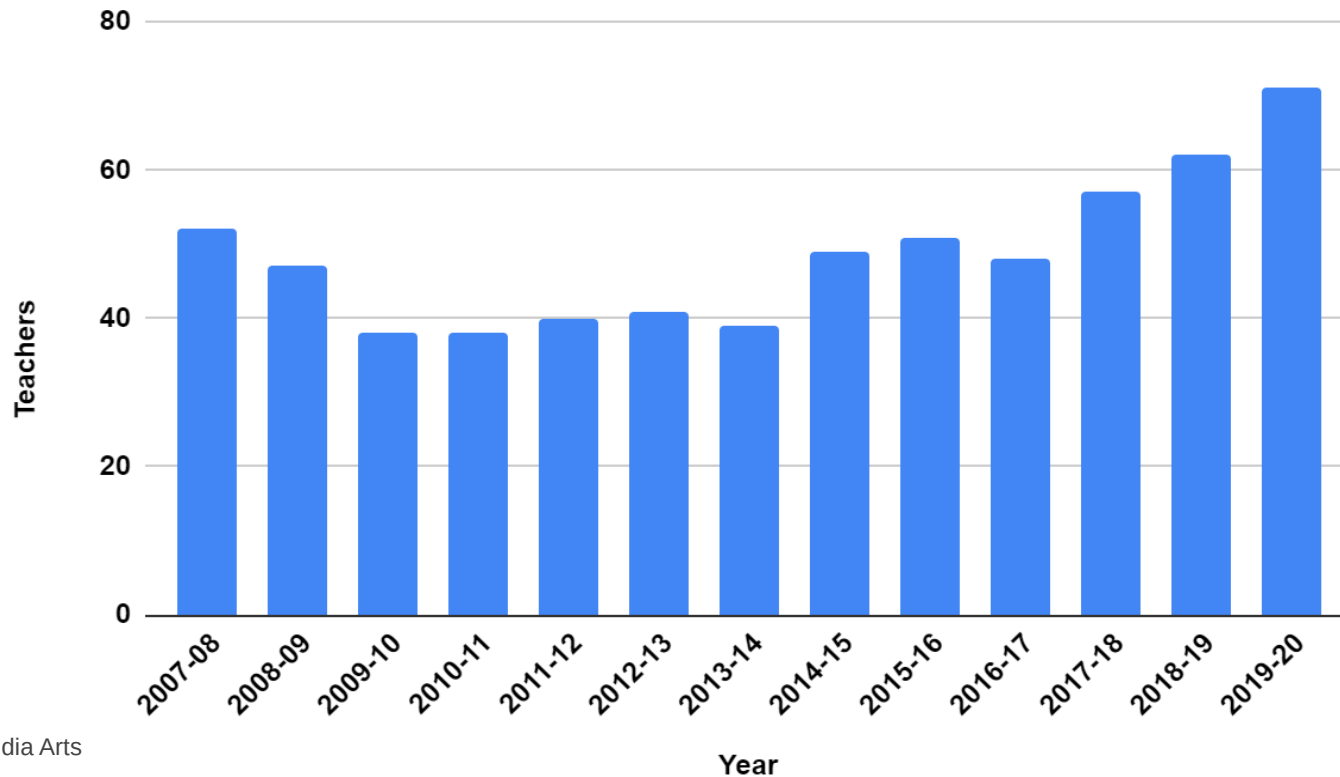

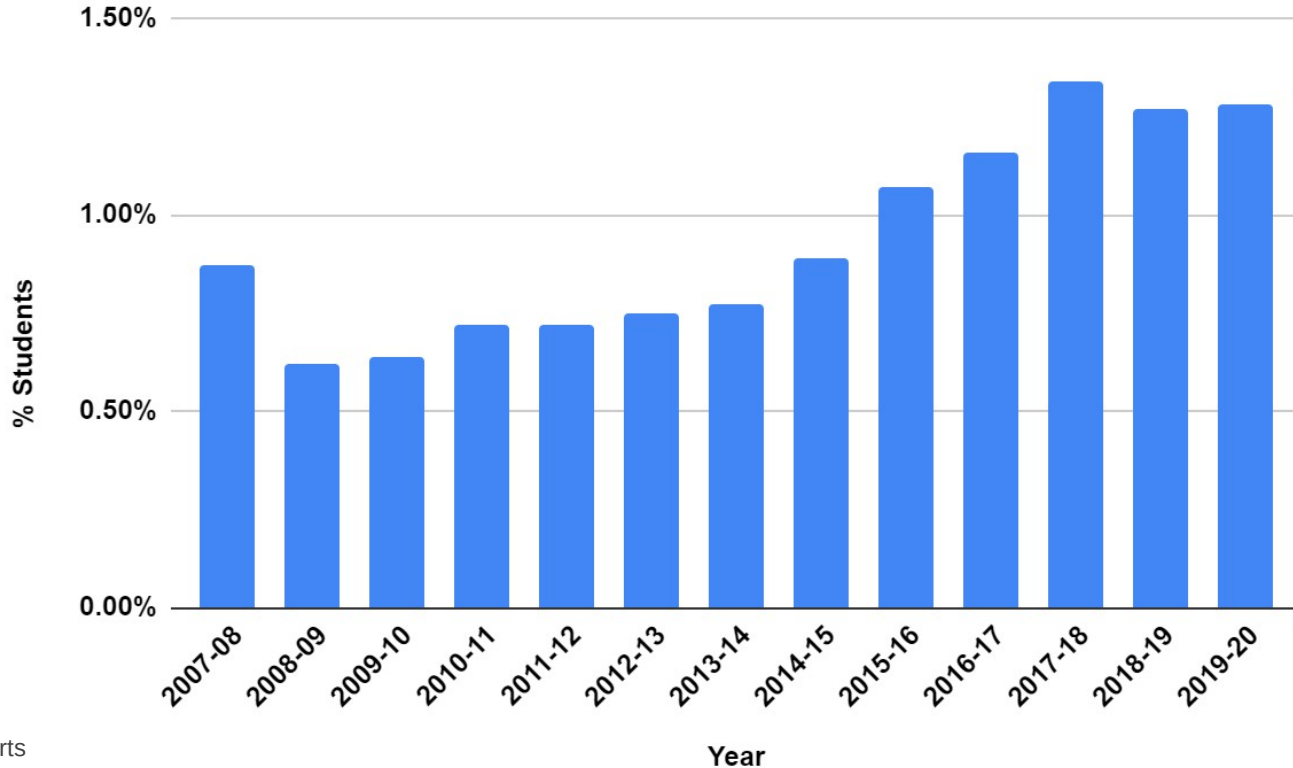

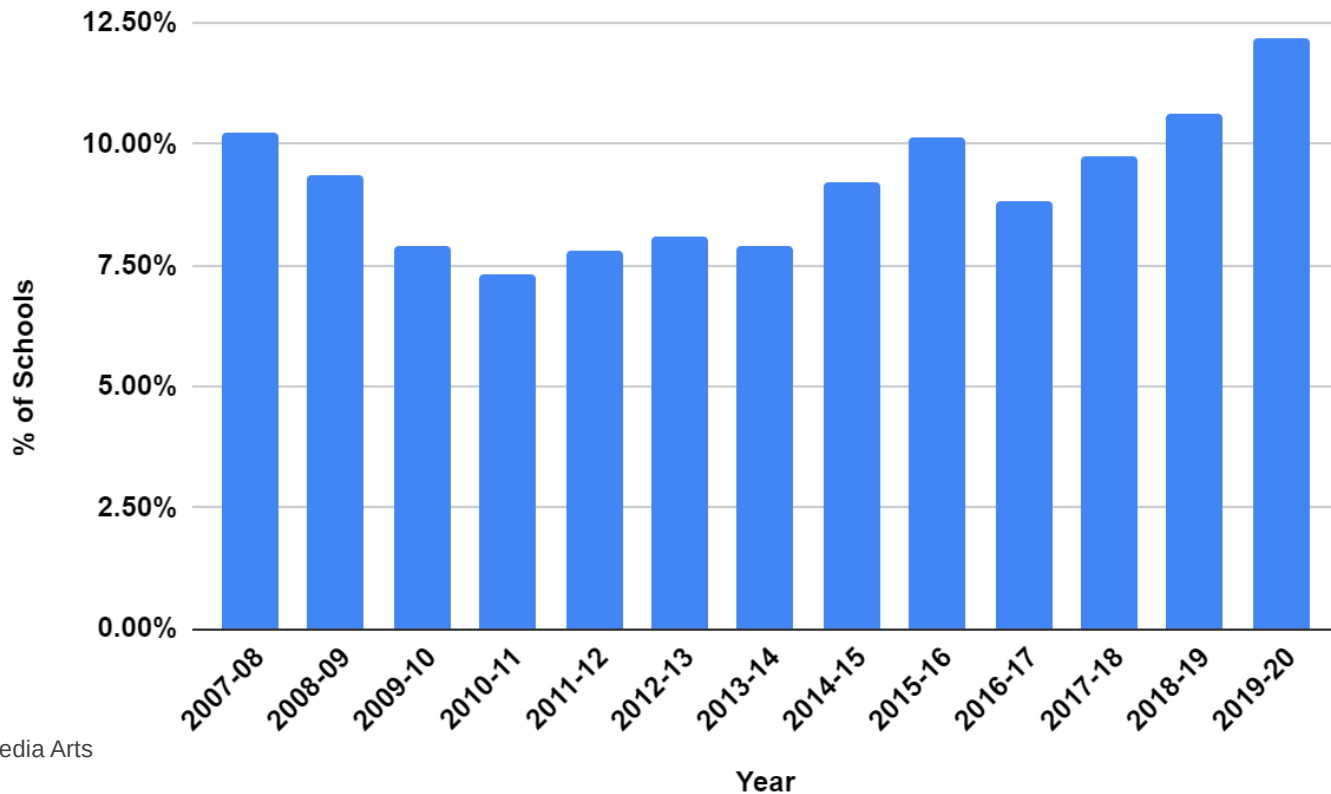
Oklahoma High School Media Production Teachers



Student Enrollment in High School Media Production Courses

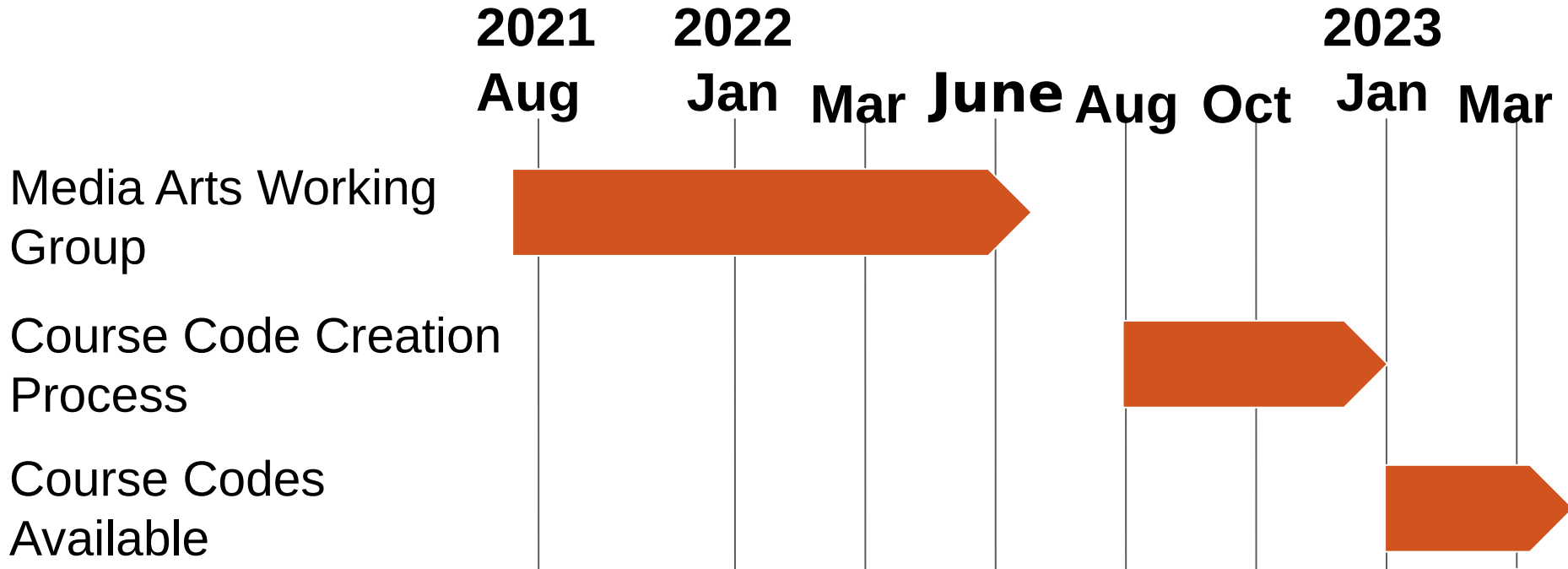


High School Sites Offering Media Production Courses

Media Arts Competencies

The **Media Arts competencies** will be written with the same guiding principles as the **Oklahoma Academic Standards for Fine Arts (OAS-FA)** and support students in the development of the **Creative Processes** outlined in the standards.

Researched best-practices, National Core Arts Standards, and **existing OAS-FA** will be utilized in creating the competencies.

Fine Arts and Graduation Requirements

23 units or sets of competencies required to meet state graduation requirements.

College Preparatory/Work Ready Graduation Requirements

- One unit or set of competencies of fine arts, such as music, art, or drama, or one unit or set of competencies of speech

Core Curriculum Graduation Requirements

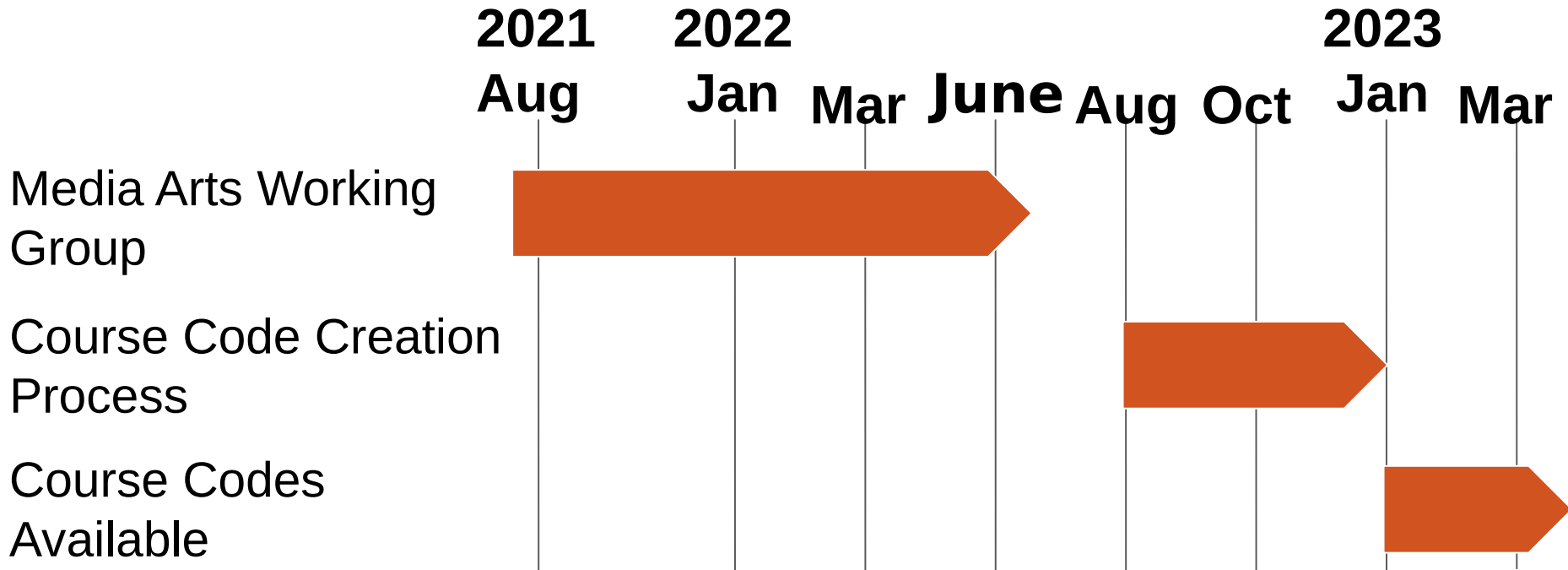
- Arts - One unit or set of competencies which may include, but is not limited to, courses in visual arts and general music

Current Requirements for Certification

Oklahoma Subject Area Test (OSAT)

- **PK-12 Visual Art**
