

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Sexual Assault Tracking System

- **SB 967, Senator Kay Floyd**
 - ✓ Effective July 1, 2019
 - ✓ Implementation by Jan. 1, 2020
 - ✓ Go-live date 10-1-2019
 - ✓ Cost to state
- **Total Users: 578**
 - ✓ 19 lab users from 5 agencies
 - ✓ 442 LE users from 228 agencies
 - ✓ 117 medical users from 42 agencies
- **Total Kits: 7,246**
 - ✓ 2,965 pre-2019 kits
 - ✓ 4,281 post-2019 kits
 - ✓ 6,359 “report kits”
 - ✓ 647 “non-report kits”

Oklahoma Sexual Assault Evidence Collection Kit Tracking System



Authorization

This website enables the tracking of sexual assault evidence kits* in the State of Oklahoma in compliance with Executive Order 2017-11.

Sexual assault evidence kit means a set of materials, such as swabs and tools for collecting blood sample, used to gather forensic evidence from a victim of reported sexual assault and the evidence obtained with such materials.

Instructions

Victims of sexual assault can view the history and current status of their sexual assault evidence kit by entering the sexual assault evidence kit tracking # in the "serial number" box above and clicking the adjacent search button with the magnifying glass icon (Q)

Authorized medical, law enforcement, county prosecutor, and lab personnel should select "Login" and enter their unique Username and Password to manage the status of sexual assault evidence kits under the jurisdiction of their agency.

The Oklahoma Sexual Assault Kit Tracking System is a program designed to track all sexual assault kits collected in Oklahoma and provide a mechanism for victim notification of kit status. OSAKTS is not intended to be an official chain of custody record for legal purposes, and is not treated as such by OSAKTS user agencies. While great effort is made to ensure the information may be relied upon as generally accurate, the intention of this system is for tracking, victim notification and public information. OSBI is not responsible for incorrect or inaccurate information contained in OSAKTS.

OSBI's Analysis

- **Title 74:150.37 Mandate**
 - ✓ Task Force vs Current Cases
 - ✓ All cases identified by the statewide audit conducted in 2017-2018 are labeled as “task force” kits and are part of the SAKI project.
 - ✓ Any kit collected in or after 2019 are labeled as a “current” kit.
 - ✓ SB 975, effective May 2019
 - ✓ Resulted in submittals/month more than tripling.
 - ✓ ~25-30 prior to SB 975
 - ✓ ~90-110 after
 - ✓ Five year comparison
 - ✓ 2017394
 - ✓ 2018425
 - ✓ 2019572
 - ✓ 20201,285
 - ✓ 20211,722

 - ✓ Bode
 - ✓ Process for contract
 - ✓ Costs
 - ✓ Y-screen only - \$645
 - ✓ 3 samples to DNA - ~\$995
 - ✓ Addl fees for (S) K - \$225
 - ✓ **Total for DNA/comp - \$1,220**
 - ✓ In-house
 - ✓ Costs
 - ✓ Serology (~4 samples) - \$205.52
 - ✓ Y-screen (~4 samples) - \$257.80
 - ✓ 4 samples to DNA - \$741.08
 - ✓ **Total for DNA/comp - \$998.88**



Untested Sexual Assault Kits

Future Outlook

- **Productivity – ~15 cases/month/analyst**
 - ✓ 40 hour work week
 - ✓ All goes well

- **Timeline to reduce backlog**
 - ✓ 10 analysts = ~150/month
 - ✓ 100 current cases plus 50 off backlog
 - ✓ ~28 months to work through backlog (**ONCE FULLY TRAINED**)
