First Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-eighth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Third Legislative Day, Wednesday, November 17, 2021

REPORT OF ENGROSSED AND ENROLLED MEASURES

SBs 1X, 2X, 4X and 5X were each correctly engrossed, properly signed and ordered transmitted to the Honorable House for consideration.

MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 1001 and 1002**.

HB 1001 – By McCall and Martinez of the House and Treat and Paxton of the Senate.
An Act relating to redistricting; creating the State House of Representatives Redistricting Act of 2021; defining relevant factors; allowing for correction of scrivener's errors; providing for adjustment of district lines by certain persons; describing composition, number and areas of legislative districts; providing terms of members; defining effect of act upon entities whose memberships are based upon legislative districts; amending 14 O.S. 2021, Section 108, which relates to qualifications of candidates; modifying residency requirements; repealing 14 O.S. 2021, Sections 138, 139, 140 and 141, which relate to the State House of Representatives Redistricting Act of 2021; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

HB 1002 – By McCall and Martinez of the House and Treat and Paxton of the Senate.
An Act relating to Congressional Districts; creating the Oklahoma Congressional Redistricting Act of 2021; providing short title; dividing the state into five Congressional Districts; stating the act shall not affect the operations of certain boards, commissions or entities; providing operative dates for Congressional Districts and conducting elections; repealing 14 O.S. 2021, Sections 6.1, 6.2, 6.3, 6.4 and 6.5, which relate to the Oklahoma Congressional Redistricting Act of 2011; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

The above-numbered measures were read the first time.

Senator McCortney moved that when the clerk's desk is clear, the Senate stand adjourned to convene Thursday, November 18, 2021, at 9:30 a.m., which motion prevailed.
