MESSAGE FROM THE GOVERNOR

Advising his approval May 4, 2022, of Enrolled **SBs 861, 942, 957, 1099, 1461, 1474, 1536, 1670, 1687, 1696** and **1742**.

Advising his veto May 4, 2022, of Enrolled **SB 1243**.

The veto message reads as follows:

To the Honorable President Pro Tempore
And Member of the Oklahoma Senate
Second Session of the
Fifty-eighth Oklahoma Legislature

ENROLLED SENATE BILL NO. 1243:

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution, I have vetoed Enrolled Senate Bill 1243.

Senate Bill 1243 creates a loophole for out-of-state and tribal titles by exempting them from inspection requirements designed to protect consumers. Furthermore, the bill – perhaps

inadvertently – legitimizes tribal titles even though, according to the Department of Public Safety, settled law indicates a number of tribally tagged and titled vehicles are currently being operated unlawfully.

For these reasons, I have vetoed Enrolled Senate Bill 1243.
