### OKLAHOMA TEENS

- About 300 teens age out of foster care every year
- 290 homeless youth aged 18-24 years
   (2020)
- 2431 births by teens aged 18-19 years (2020)
  - 56% of teen moms had a repeat birth within 24 months



### AGING-OUT OF FOSTER CARE INCREASES RISKS FOR:

7 our of 10 girls leaving foster care at 18 will be pregnant by age 21. By age 26, 46% of foster care alumni experience at least one episode of homelessness.

Foster care alumni can suffer from:

- Domestic Violence
- Sexual Volence
- Traumatic Loss
- Neglect

81% experienced maltreatment

50.8% experienced sexual abuse

49.8% experienced neglect

### PREVENTION WORKS



Decreases the odds of being homeless by 28%



Decreases the odds of an arrest of jail time by 40%



Decreases pregnancy risk by 28%



Increases the likelihood of employment by 18%



3x's more likely to be enrolled in school
