## First Regular Session of the Fifty-ninth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

**Fifty-seventh Legislative Day, Tuesday, May 16, 2023**

The Senate was called to order by Senator Coleman.

### GENERAL ORDER

**SB 1196** by Howard of the Senate and Kannady of the House was called up for consideration.

Senator Howard moved to amend **SB 1196**, Page 8, Line 6, by deleting section 2 and renumbering subsequent sections, which amendment was declared adopted.

Senator Howard moved that **SB 1196** be advanced, which motion was declared adopted.
