## First Regular Session of the Fifty-ninth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

**Thirty-seventh Legislative Day, Tuesday, April 11, 2023**

The Senate was called to order by Senator Hall.

Upon motion of Representative Echols, the Third Joint Session was ordered dissolved at the hour of 10:30 a.m.
