## Second Regular Session of the Fifty-ninth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Seventh Legislative Day, Wednesday, February 14, 2024

**HB 2975** – By West (Rick) and Hefner of the House and Hamilton of the Senate.

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 5-4.3, which relates to the Homemade Food Freedom Act; providing homemade food product producer registration number and fee; providing for registration number to be used on labeling and omitting certain information; and providing an effective date.
