Fifteenth Legislative Day, Wednesday, February 28, 2024

REPORT OF ENGROSSED AND ENROLLED MEASURES

SBs 1296, 1340, 1438, 1491, 1516, 1521 and 1528 were each correctly engrossed, properly signed and ordered transmitted to the Honorable House for consideration.

HB 3053 – By Boles and Williams of the House and Rader of the Senate.

An Act relating to energy; requiring Secretary of Energy and Environment to evaluate relationship of the Southwest Power Pool and the state; requiring preparation of certain report; providing for staffing; requiring report encompass certain areas; providing report be completed by certain date; providing for distribution of report; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

HB 3333 – By Roe and Swope of the House and Dossett of the Senate.

An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-103a.1, which relates to creation of Public Health Advisory Councils; creating exception; increasing membership of the Advancement of Wellness Advisory Council; directing appointment of certain members; broadening jurisdictional areas of the Advancement of Wellness Advisory Council; and providing an effective date.

HB 3467 – By Moore of the House and Howard of the Senate.

An Act relating to civil procedure; amending 12 O.S. 2021, Section 1513, which relates to partition by sale; providing for some property to be divided in kind while remaining property to be portioned by sale; providing procedure for subdividing property; providing procedure for sale; defining term; and providing an effective date.

HB 3509 – By Johns of the House and Stewart of the Senate.

An Act relating to Oklahoma Coordinate System; amending 60 O.S. 2021, Sections 1001, 1002, 1004, 1005, 1007, 1008, and 1009, which relate Oklahoma Coordinate System; adding references to the Oklahoma Plane Coordinate System; repealing 60 O.S. 2021, Section 1006, which relates to limitations on recording coordinates; and providing an effective date.
