

# Senate Journal

## Second Regular Session of the Fifty-ninth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma Thirty-eighth Legislative Day, Thursday, April 11, 2024

The Senate was called to order by Senator Coleman.

### GENERAL ORDER

**HB 2956** by Kendrix of the House and Bergstrom of the Senate was called up for consideration.

Senator Bergstrom moved to amend **HB 2956**, Page 2, Line 4½, by inserting new Sections 2 and 3 to read as follows:

“SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.”; and by amending the title to conform, which amendment was declared adopted.

Senator Bergstrom moved that **HB 2956** be advanced, which motion was declared adopted.

### **THIRD READING**

**HB 2956** was read for the third time at length.

On the question of passage of the bill and emergency, the vote resulted as follows:
