






"Foundations, endowments, and family offices often separate the corpus of their wealth from the activities that are meaningful to them. For example, in the typical endowment, 95 percent of assets have one goal: to grow as much as possible; only 5 percent annually goes to grantmaking activities. The typical pension fund invests 95 per cent of the assets with a goal of growing the fund's value, and pays out 5% annually in pensions. Even though the foundations care for a particular place, and public pension funds care for the welfare of a community's residents, it may be the case that investments from the 95% actively hurt the people for whom the 5% is designated to help."






Oklahoma City Venture Funds Invested In






Oklahoma Venture Funds Invested In






Oklahoma City Startups Invested In


