## First Regular Session of the Sixtieth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

**Fifteenth Legislative Day, Wednesday, February 26, 2025**

**HB 1034** – By Kendrix of the House and Bergstrom of the Senate.

An Act relating to sunset; amending 67 O.S. 2021, Section 305, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 189, O.S.L. 2022 (67 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 305), which relates to the Archives and Records Commission; re-creating the Commission; and modifying the termination date.

**HB 1035** – By Kendrix of the House and Bergstrom of the Senate.

An Act relating to sunset; amending 73 O.S. 2021, Section 83.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 91, O.S.L. 2022 (73 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 83.1), which relates to the Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and Zoning Commission; re-creating the Commission; and modifying the termination date.

**HB 1376** – By Boles and Hill of the House and Thompson of the Senate.

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section 5060.26, which relates to the Oklahoma Alliance for Manufacturing Excellence; modifying composition of board of directors; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
