### **Pardons – Current Practice**

- PPB's Authority: Recommendation only (OK Constitution, Art. VI, sec. 10)
- Eligibility: Set Forth in Administrative Rules (Title 515, Chapter 20)
- Procedure: Set Forth in Administrative Rules and PPB Policy
- Docket Size: 25-30 Applications Per Month
- FY2025 Recommendation Rate: 91.3%



### Pardons – Major Changes, 2020-2025

#### Eligibility:

- Expanded eligibility to include indefinite parole or probationary sentences, and
- Added five-year waiting period to apply for pardon

#### Procedure:

- Transitioned from paper applications to an online application system,
- Brought pre-pardon investigations back in-house, and
- Contracted with University of Oklahoma for tracking of pardon data, beginning FY 2022



# Pardons – Improvement Opportunities

- Integration With ICON for increased automation
- Increase Efficiencies in Pardon Process to Reduce Timeline
- Expedited Review Process Based Upon Criteria

### **Parole – Current Practice**

- PPB's Authority: Recommendation only for violent crimes; Parole-granting authority for nonviolent crimes (OK Constitution, Art. VI, sec. 10)
- Eligibility: Set Forth in Statute (Title 57, Chapter 7)
- Procedure: Primarily Set Forth in Statute (57 O.S. § 332.7)
- Docket Size: 350-400 paroles docketed per month (408 in September 2025)
- FY2024 Recommendation Rates:
  - Violent: 7.4%
  - Nonviolent: 19.4%



# Parole – Major Changes, 2020-2025

#### Eligibility:

Administrative parole expanded following 2022 law change

#### Procedure:

- Transition to ICON offender management and reporting system
- Contracted with University of Oklahoma for tracking of parole data

#### Docket Sizes:

Increase from 3,315 in FY 2020 to 4882 in FY 2025



# **Parole – Improvement Opportunities**

- Enhancements to ICON regarding data management and collation, and automation
- Collaboration with DOC for improvements to investigative and Board review process
- Modernize victim notification practices through technological and statutory changes

#### **Commutation – Current Practice**

- PPB's Authority: Recommendation only (OK Constitution, Art. VI, sec. 10)
- Eligibility: Set Forth in Administrative Rules (Title 515, Chapter 15)
- Procedure: Set Forth in Statute (57 O.S. § 332.2), Administrative Rules, and PPB Policy
- Docket Size: 25-30 Applications Per Month
- FY2024 Recommendation Rate: 7.8%



### **Commutation – Major Changes, 2020-2025**

#### • Eligibility:

- Adopted rule for a waiting period for commutation eligibility
  - Shorter of five years, or 1/3 of total length of sentence(s)

#### Procedure:

- Transitioned from paper review to online application review system, with automated notification to stakeholders
- Contracted with University of Oklahoma for tracking of commutation data, FY2022

#### Docket Sizes:

Decrease from 2,168 in FY 2020 to 358 in FY 2024



### **Commutation – Improvement Opportunities**

- Increased integration with ICON for application review and automation
- Linking victim notifications with application review system

### **Capital Clemency – Current Practice**

- PPB's Authority: Recommendation only (OK Constitution, Art. VI, sec. 10)
- Eligibility: Set Forth in OK Constitution
- Procedure: Set Forth in Administrative Rules (Title 515, Chapter 10)
- 20 clemency hearings held since the resumption of executions in 2021
- 5 recommendations for clemency



# Capital Clemency – Major Changes, 2020-2025

#### Procedure:

- Clemency packets submitted electronically
- Hearings available to watch via ZOOM
- Resumption of Clemency Hearings:
  - Average of four hearings held per year since resumption of execution



# **Capital Clemency – Improvement Opportunities**

Reduction of litigation risk through changes to policy and procedure

# **Opportunities for Legislative Changes**

#### Victim Notifications:

- Board is required by statute to provide various notifications by mail (57 O.S. § 332.2)
- Allowing electronic notification would improve victims' awareness and produce cost savings for the Board

#### Board Member Salaries:

- Board member salaries are set by statute (57 O.S. § 332.4) and have not been adjusted since 2002
- Over same time, Board member workloads continue to increase year-over-year
- Stability of Board membership advances Constitutional mandate more effectively
- Collaboration With Legislature to Advance State's Policy Objectives:
  - Board's executive team takes a collective approach to working with policymakers and stakeholders to align agency practices with Oklahoma's policy objectives
