It administers the rules governing lobbyists, campaign finance, conflicts of interest and financial disclosure. This includes promulgation, education, compliance review, and enforcement. The division functions as a repository for all registrations and reports filed by candidate committees, political action committees, party committees, special function committees, financial disclosure, and lobbyist and legislative liaisons.

Political Subdivision Enforcement Division created in 2014 for the enforcement of the Local Government Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure act. The Commission is not required to enforce the Local Government Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act unless the fund created for the Division has \$100,000 or more.
