How would the agency handle a 5% appropriation reduction in FY'16?

The Agency's FY-2015 appropriation of \$1,423,345 would be reduced by \$71,167 for a FY-2016 appropriation of \$1,352,178 and all expenditures for safety & security equipment and supplies, library resources and field agent/staff training would be reduced and/or tabled in order to protect the current FTE's from furloughs or reductions.
