

STATE APPROPRIATION - SELECT AGENCIES
REQUEST FOR LICENSE FEE COMPARISON WITH SURROUNDING STATES - January 2017

The CIB is a non-appropriated, self-funded agency. The CIB receives no federal funds and is funded by license and registration fees, as shown below, pursuant to the various statutory acts and administrative rules as adopted through the legislative rulemaking process of the Administrative Procedures Act. The CIB pays 10% of its fees into the state General Fund, as well as paying the state for the OMES shared services it acquires (IT, Financial, HCM, and mailing) and the Office of Attorney General to advise the CIB and the skilled trade committees. In FY 2015, the CIB paid almost \$400,000 into the state General Fund.

*NOTE: No state has the same category, classifications, and requirements as Oklahoma. Other state fee information is not information previously collected or maintained by the CIB. License fees, application fees, exam fees, insurance, bond and financial requirements vary among the states. Most other states have multiple licensing agencies since the major skilled trades are not streamlined under an umbrella agency like the CIB in Oklahoma. Only application and license fees, when found, are addressed below. The information was gathered from multiple sources; and, the information frequently was not consistent. Other states' categories were aligned to the best of our ability with Oklahoma's to better provide comparison between two fee items not necessarily consisting of the same factors. For the information to be reliable, time would be required to confirm the information directly with the various and multiple licensing agencies.
