



SY18-19 Academic Growth



Tulsa Honor Academy: Project Plan

Phase I

- August 2020 delivery
- Site acquisition & planning
- ~40,000 sq ft for 500 HS students, initially 9th & 10th grade
- Preliminary budget of \$6.7MM

Phase II

- August 2022 delivery
- ~32,500 additional sq ft for 410 MS student program
- Preliminary budget of \$4.3MM

Following Phase II THA wants to explore additional build out of arts, athletics and extracurricular spaces
