Second Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma Forty-fifth Legislative Day, Monday, May 1, 2006

“I have signed Senate Joint Resolution No. 32 and have caused the same to be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State. I sign this Senate Joint resolution to allow more time for those affected to get prepared for the 2008 implementation of the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP). However, Oklahoma must conform to the Uniform Standards prior to January 1, 2008, and I strongly encourage the Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board and the Legislature to work closely together to resolve this issue as soon as possible.”
