First Regular Session of the Fifty-first Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Thirty-seventh Legislative Day, Monday, April 9, 2007

Senator Crain moved to amend **HB 1340**, Page 10, Line 2, by inserting after the words "submission of" and before the word "an" the following ": (1)"; and Page 10, Lines 5 through 7, by deleting after the words "home and" on Line 5 and before the word "A" on Line 7, all new language, and inserting the following:

"(2) a title opinion by a licensed attorney, determining that the owner of the manufactured home has marketable title to the real property upon which the manufactured home is located and that no documents filed of record in the county clerk's office concerning the real property contain a mortgage, recorded financial statement, judgment, or lien of record. Persons or entities to whom the title opinion is addressed may rely on said title opinion.", and by amending the title to conform.

Senator Crutchfield asked that **HB 1340** be laid over temporarily, which was the order.

HB 1340 remains on General Order pending consideration of the Crain amendment.
