MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 1010, 1335, 1528** and **1904**.

HB 1010 – By Brown of the House and Wyrick of the Senate.

An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S. 2011, Section 5-401, which relates to the Wildlife Conservation Commission; specifying Upper Illinois River bowfishing season; and providing an effective date.

HB 1335 – By Lockhart of the House and Ballenger of the Senate.

An Act relating to schools; requiring certain company to provide refund to teacher candidates under certain condition; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HB 1528 – By Banz of the House and Ford of the Senate.

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 6-101.23, which relates to the application of the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990; modifying number of temporary contracts on which a teacher may be hired; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

HB 1904 – By Cleveland, Ritze and Bennett of the House and Sparks of the Senate.

An Act relating to volunteer fire departments; amending 11 O.S. 2011, Section 29-203, which relates to the Oklahoma Volunteer Firefighters Act; allowing volunteer fire department to increase membership if serving certain area; and providing an effective date.
