MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 1747, 1825 and 1965**.

HB 1747 – By Newell, Hickman, Sanders, Biggs, Murdock, Pfeiffer, Ortega, Johnson, Osborn, Park and Vaughan of the House and Schulz, Boggs and Smalley of the Senate.

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2358 as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 138 O.S.L. 2014 (68 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 2358), which relates to computation of taxable income and adjusted gross income; providing exemption for income received by persons resident of certain counties; prescribing limit on duration of exemption; prescribing standard for purposes of determining projected county population loss; and providing an effective date.

HB 1825 – By Martin of the House and Standridge of the Senate.

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68 O.S. 2011, Section 205.2, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 266, O.S.L. 2013 (68 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 205.2), which relates to claims by certain governmental entities; modifying provisions related to claims for certain health care service costs; and declaring an emergency.

HB 1965 – By ODonnell, Rogers, Perryman, Christian, Sherrer, Virgin, Brown, Shelton, Montgomery, McDaniel (Jeannie) and Hoskin of the House and Sharp of the Senate.

An Act relating to motor vehicles; creating the Trooper Nicholas Dees and Trooper Keith Burch Act of 2015; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-901c, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 207, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 11-901c), which relates to the unlawful use of a cellular telephone or electronic communication device; modifying scope of certain prohibited act; clarifying language; defining terms; providing exceptions; specifying information that is admissible as evidence; providing method of enforcement; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.
