Twelfth Legislative Day, Wednesday, February 22, 2017

MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 1116, 1187, 1197, 1204, 1298, 1466, 1821 and 1875** and **HJR 1002**.

HB 1116 – By Sanders and Biggs of the House and Griffin of the Senate.

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Evidence Code; authorizing the admissibility of statements made by vulnerable or incapacitated persons in certain circumstances; requiring notice to adverse party; defining terms; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HB 1187 – By Frix, McEntire and Faught of the House and Thompson of the Senate.

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; defining term; prohibiting enactment of tax incentives without inclusion of specific date after which incentive not authorized; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HB 1197 – By Hardin and Ritze of the House and Simpson of the Senate.

An Act relating to veterans; amending 72 O.S. 2011, Section 2, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 213, O.S.L. 2014 (72 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2), which relates to definition; modifying definition; and providing an effective date.

HB 1204 – By Casey of the House and Fields of the Senate.

An Act relating to officers; amending 51 O.S. 2011, Section 6, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 297, O.S.L. 2016 (51 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 6), which relates to dual office holding; providing dual office holding exemption for certain agents of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; and providing an effective date.

HB 1298 – By Sears of the House and Paxton of the Senate.

An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1820.6, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 111, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1820.6), which relates to the Fire Extinguisher Industry Committee; modifying meeting procedures; and providing an effective date.

HB 1466 – By Hall, Biggs and West (Josh) of the House and Griffin of the Senate.

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 2011, Section 60.4, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 281, O.S.L. 2016 (22 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 60.4), which relates to the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act; authorizing transfer of wireless telephone number or numbers and household utility account under certain circumstances; requiring inclusion of certain information on transfer order; prohibiting release of contact information; directing transmission of final protective order to wireless service provider and public utility provider; requiring notice when wireless service provider or public utility provider cannot effectuate transfer order; assigning financial responsibility of transferred number or numbers and utility account and associated costs to petitioner; authorizing wireless service providers and public utility providers to apply account requirements for transferred numbers, devices and utility account; providing liability exemption for providers; defining terms; and providing an effective date.

HB 1821 – By Kannady of the House and Standridge of the Senate.

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-103, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 305, O.S.L. 2015 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2-103), which relates to powers and duties of the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; increasing hours of mandatory training for reserve special agents; providing employees in classified positions the right to return to classified service under certain circumstances; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-502, which relates to inspections of prescriptions, orders and records; authorizing Director to designate certain personnel as compliance inspectors; adding exception to certain prohibited conduct; and providing an effective date.

HB 1875 – By Dunnington, Proctor, Montgomery, Osborn (Leslie) and Inman of the House and Griffin of the Senate.

An Act relating to schools; defining certain terms; permitting schools to donate food to a nonprofit organization through certain individuals; providing examples of food that may be included; permitting food donated to a nonprofit organization to be redistributed on the school site; permitting certain employees to assist in preparing and distributing food; providing certain exemption from liability; permitting State Board of Education to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HJR 1002 – By Biggs, Downing, Sanders, Wright, Jordan and McBride of the House and Sykes of the Senate.

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 34 of Article II of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; clarifying justice and due process rights of victims; enumerating rights; authorizing victims to assert and enforce said rights; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

The above-numbered measures were read the first time.
