Fourteenth Legislative Day, Thursday, November 9, 2017

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HB 1058**.

HB 1058 – By Wallace, Casey and Bennett (John) of the House and David, Fields and Simpson of the Senate.

An Act relating to the Department of Human Services; requiring certain appropriated funds to be used for certain purposes; providing legislative intent; providing for impact of restoration of funds on remaining months of FY-18 budget; and declaring an emergency.
