First Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Eighteenth Legislative Day, Thursday, November 16, 2017

The Senate was called to order by Senator Stanislawski.

FIRST READING

The following was introduced and read the first time:

A Resolution recognizing and celebrating the 110th anniversary of Oklahoma Statehood Day.

Senator Schulz asked unanimous consent to refer **SR 3X** direct to the Calendar for consideration, which was the order.

GENERAL ORDER

SR 3X was adopted upon motion of Senator Schulz and referred for enrollment.

GENERAL ORDER

HB 1074 by Cleveland and Osborn (Leslie) of the House and Sharp of the Senate was called up for consideration.

Senator Sharp moved that **HB 1074** be advanced, which motion was declared adopted.

THIRD READING

HB 1074 was read for the third time at length.
