First Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Nineteenth Legislative Day, Friday, November 17, 2017

The Senate was called to order by Senator Fields.

Roll Call:

Senator Fields declared a quorum present.

The prayer was offered by Associate Pastor Dan Boone, Church of the Harvest, Oklahoma City, the guest of President Pro Tempore Schulz.

GENERAL ORDER

HB 1085 by Wallace and Casey of the House and Schulz of the Senate was called up for consideration.

Senator Treat moved that **HB 1085X** be advanced, which motion was declared adopted.

THIRD READING

HB 1085 was read for the third time at length.

On the question of passage of the bill, the vote resulted as follows:

Excused: Holt, Matthews, Newhouse and Pittman.--4.

Vacancy: Districts 27 and 45.--2.

The bill passed.

Senators Stanislawski, Bice, Bergstrom, Sykes, Pugh and Brown desired to vote Aye on the emergency.

On the question of passage of the emergency, the vote resulted as follows: Aye: 33; Nay: 9; Excused: 4; Vacancy: Districts 27 and 45--2.

The emergency passed.

HB 1085 was properly signed and ordered returned to the Honorable House.
