MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 2537, 3064** and **3302**.

HB 2537 – By West (Tammy) and Roberts (Dustin) of the House and Dugger and David of the Senate.

An Act relating to public health and safety; requiring assisted living centers to have certain hours of alternate sources of energy by certain date; requiring newly licensed assisted living centers to meet requirements upon licensure; and providing an effective date.

HB 3064 – By ODonnell of the House and Quinn of the Senate.

An Act relating to vulnerable adults; requiring Office of the Attorney General to promulgate rules to establish and maintain certain registry by certain date; requiring registry to contain certain information; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HB 3302 – By Wright of the House and Griffin of the Senate.

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 888, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 128, O.S.L. 2017 (21 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 888), which relates to the crime of forcible sodomy; expanding scope of crime to include certain persons; defining phrase; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1111, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 128, O.S.L. 2017 (21 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1111), which relates to the crime of rape; expanding scope of crime to include certain persons; defining phrase; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1123, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 128, O.S.L. 2017 (21 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1123), which relates to lewd or indecent acts to a child; expanding scope of certain prohibited act; providing separate penalty for certain persons; defining phrase; and providing an effective date.
