MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 2634** and **2926**.

HB 2634 – By Babinec and Ritze of the House and Fry of the Senate.

An Act relating to public safety; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-102, which relates to the position of the Commissioner of Public Safety; allowing employee to return to previous position upon completion of duties as Commissioner; providing certain disqualifications for employee returning to service; and providing an effective date.

HB 2926 – By Frix, Osborn (Leslie), Kerbs and Bush of the House and Pemberton of the Senate.

An Act relating to public buildings and public works; amending 61 O.S. 2011, Section 103, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 186, O.S.L. 2013 (61 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 103), which relates to the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974; authorizing certain entities with option to match lowest bid; and providing an effective date.
