Second Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Tenth Legislative Day, Monday, February 26, 2018

MESSAGES FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 1034** and **1036**.

HB 1034 – By Wallace and Casey of the House and David and Fields of the Senate.

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2357.11, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 390, O.S.L. 2016 (68 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 2357.11), which relates to income tax credits for coal production; imposing cap; prescribing formula for computation of cap amount; providing for certain carryover amounts; and providing an effective date.

HB 1036 – By Wallace and Casey of the House and David and Fields of the Senate.

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2357.104, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 2016 (68 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 2357.104), which relates to income tax credits for railroad reconstruction expenditures; imposing cap; prescribing formula for computation of cap amount; providing for certain carryover amounts; and providing an effective date.

The above-numbered measures were read the first time.

Advising fourth reading of and transmitting for signature Enrolled **HBs 1020** and **1021**.

The above-numbered enrolled measures were, after fourth reading, properly signed and ordered returned to the Honorable House.
