Second Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Sixteenth Legislative Day, Wednesday, March 14, 2018

The Senate was called to order by Senator Fields.

Senator Fields declared a quorum present.

PENDING CONSIDERATION OF JCR

The **JCR** on **HB 1033** was adopted upon motion of Senator David.

Senator David moved pursuant to the provisions of subsection (b) of Joint Rule 8, which allows the membership of a single chamber to suspend the Joint Rules by a 2/3 vote of the membership of a single chamber on a matter affecting actions of that chamber only, I ask unanimous consent to suspend the provisions of Joint Rules 3 and 4.9 and Senate Rules 8-23(A) and 11-1(A)(1) to allow the Senate to consider Floor Amendment 2 to **HB 1033**.

Senator David moved to amend **HB 1033**, by substituting the attached floor substitute for the title, enacting clause and entire body of the measure, which amendment was declared adopted. (Copies were provided for all Senators.)

HB 1033 was read at length.

On the question of passage of the bill, the vote resulted as follows:

Senator Bice advised that **HB 1033** received less than the 3/4 vote required by Section 33 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma Constitution but did receive enough votes that it could move forward as a ballot measure.

Pursuant to Rule 8-32, Senator David served notice that the vote be reconsidered whereby **HB 1033** passed.

REQUEST TO RECESS

Senator Treat moved to request the Honorable House of Representatives to consent to the adjournment of the Senate in the Second Extraordinary Session of the 56th Legislature for a period of more than three days, pursuant to Article 5, Section 30 of the Oklahoma Constitution, beginning Thursday, March 15, 2018 and ending at the Call of the Chair, which motion was declared adopted.
