MESSAGE FROM THE HOUSE

Advising passage of and transmitting for consideration Engrossed **HBs 1423, 2030, 2037** and **2373**.

HB 1423 – By Hardin (David) of the House and Shaw of the Senate.

An Act relating to waters and water rights; directing Grand River Dam Authority to promulgate rules and procedures relating to the beneficial removal of gravel from the Barren Fork and Illinois Rivers; requiring state and federal permitting; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

HB 2030 – By Cornwell of the House and Murdock of the Senate.

An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S. 2011, Section 4-114, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 112, O.S.L. 2014 (29 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 4-114), which relates to hunting and fishing licenses; creating a nonresident lifetime combination hunting and fishing license; and providing an effective date.

HB 2037 – By Davis of the House and Rader of the Senate.

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-125, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 2-125), which relates to the deposit and expenditure of funds; allowing county sheriffs to collect certain fees; directing where collected fees shall be deposited; specifying use of received fees; and providing an effective date.

HB 2373 – By McBride of the House and Daniels of the Senate.

An Act relating to nuisances; amending 50 O.S. 2011, Section 1.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 276, O.S.L. 2017 (50 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1.1), which relates to agricultural activity actions for nuisance; requiring separate determination for noneconomic damages; prescribing limitation for noneconomic damages awarded to plaintiff; and providing an effective date.
