First Regular Session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Twenty-seventh Legislative Day, Tuesday, March 19, 2019

The Senate was called to order by Senator Bice.

GENERAL ORDER

SB 1041 by Daniels of the Senate and Kannady of the House was called up for consideration.

Senator Daniels moved to amend **SB 1041**, Page 10, Lines 12 through 16, by deleting all the new language of subsection G, which amendment was declared adopted.

Senator Daniels moved that **SB 1041** be advanced, which motion was declared adopted.
