#### Sixty-first Legislative Day, Monday, May 20, 2019

**PENDING CONSIDERATION OF CCR**

The **CCR** on **SB 879** was brought up for consideration upon motion of Senator Dahm.

Senator Pederson raised a point of order regarding the Conference Committee Substitute for **SB 879**, stating the provisions of Section 1 of the Conference Committee Substitute have the same effect and cover substantially similar subject matter as the provisions of Section 1 of Engrossed **HB 2324**, which failed in the Senate Agriculture and Wildlife Committee on April 8, 2019.

After examining the bills in question and reviewing the legislative history, the Chair made the following ruling:

1. Section 1 of the CCS for **SB 879** is substantially similar to Section 1 of Engrossed **HB 2324**; and
2. **HB 2324** failed in the Agriculture and Wildlife Committee on April 8, 2019; and
3. The **CCR** for **SB 879** is therefore out of order pursuant to the final action provisions of Senate Rule 6-7.

Senator Dahm challenged the ruling of the Chair and offered the following Substitute Ruling Motion pursuant to Senate Rule 9-14:

**SB 879** in its entirety (not just Section 1) is substantially different and, therefore, not subject to final action according to Senate Rule 6-7.
