An Act relating to the State Capital and Capitol Building; amending 73 O.S. 2011, Section 15.1, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 335, O.S.L. 2016 (73 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 15.1), which relates to control of space by the Legislature; modifying allotment of certain space; defining terms; and declaring an emergency.
